4. Government debt securities Buybacks

Throughout October ARDAL realized buyback trades of government bonds: direct trade of bond Slovak 2015 XS0430015742 in nominal amount EUR 4.68 million was done on October 6th with price 101.27 %, direct buyback trade of bond Slovak 2015 XS0430015742 in nominal amount EUR 54.6 million was done on October 8th with price 101.2495 %, direct buyback trade of bond Slovak 2015 XS0430015742 in nominal amount EUR 21.6 million was done on October 23rd with price 101.07 %, direct buyback trade of bond Slovak 2015 XS0430015742 in nominal amount EUR 52.55 million was done on October 30th with price 100.9852 %, direct buyback trade of bond ŠD 210 in nominal amount EUR 26.6 million was done on October 30th with price 100.0606 %, direct buyback trade of bond Slovak 2015 XS0430015742 in nominal amount EUR 6.9 million was done on October 31st with price 100.9758 %, direct buyback trade of bond ŠD 210 in nominal amount EUR 300.0 million was done on October

31st with price 100.0645 % and direct buyback trade of bond ŠD 210 in nominal amount EUR 13.5 million was done on October 31st with price 100.06 %.

Till the end of year 2014 ARDAL want to buy back bonds maturing in January 2015, namely SD 210 ISIN SK4120006503 registered and listed in Slovakia and SLOVAK 2015 ISIN XS0430015742 registered in Luxembourg and listed in London. Price of buybacks will be derived from Money-Market price for relevant time period.

9. Outlook for November 2014

In November there is no redemption of government financial liabilities coming from government bonds and T-bills.

On the base of PDs responses and issuer's decision there will be government bond ŠD 219 (coupon fix rate 4.625 % p. a. with residual tenor 2.17 years) and of government bond ŠD 225 (coupon fixed rate 3.000 % p. a. with residual tenor 8.27 years) auction.

Auction of both bonds will take place on November 18th – on Tuesday (on Monday November 17th there is holiday in Slovakia). **Settlement day on will be T+2 i.e. November 20th, 2014.**

In November 19^{th} will be buy back auction government bond ŠD 210 and Slovak 2015. Settlement day on will be T+2 i.e. November 21^{st} , 2014.

In line with other EMU countries Slovakia is changing settlement day on primary market of state debt securities to T+2 commencing October 6th, 2014.
